



## QUALIFYING RACE CHARTER

### Conditions :

1. Only races validated by the ITRA and who have made the express request to be a qualifying race.
2. A race can be a qualifying race based on the evaluation realised by the International Trail Running Association (ITRA - [www.i-tra.org](http://www.i-tra.org)) each year.
3. If for one reason, or another the route realised does not correspond to that which was evaluated, the UTMB® will remove the race from its list, while awaiting an evaluation of the actual route realised.
4. Only the UTMB® can take decisions concerning qualifying rules.
5. Subject to strictly respecting all the conditions of the charter expressed below, the race can be a qualifying race at the discretion of the organisation of the UTMB®. A refusal will not have be justified.
6. The UTMB® includes the race on their list of qualifying races and supplies the corresponding logo.
7. A race is a qualifier for one year. The request for qualification and the evaluation certificate must be renewed each year.ar.

**NB : Only an organiser can request that their race(s) is/are qualifying races.**

**The UTMB® will redirect any runner, wishing a race to be a qualifying race, to the organisers concerned.**

### The organiser of a qualifying race, categorically, agrees to commit to the following points:

1. To post, within 10 days following their race, individuals' results on their ITRA organiser's page, which centralises the data. So, at the moment of registration, the UTMB® is able to verify that each runner has sufficient qualifying points to permit him to register.
2. The only logo which may be used to indicate that a race is a qualifying race is that supplied by the UTMB®
3. The qualifying race logo can only be applied to qualifying races. This point is made in particular for events which have several races, not all of which are qualifying races.
4. In the case of the use of this logo on a race web-site, the link to [www.utmbmontblanc.com](http://www.utmbmontblanc.com) must, imperatively, be added.
5. The qualifying races give points for all the races of the UTMB® event.
6. To respect the official trade names: Ultra-Trail®, Ultra-Trail du Mont-Blanc®, UTMB®, CCC®, TDS® et PTL® as well as the UTMB® 's little man logo which are all legal names registered with the INPI (France) and/or the European Union's Office of Harmonisation and/or the World Organisation of International Property (WIPO). This implies that none of these vocables can be used in either a descriptive manner, or as plural common noun. Moreover, all use of one of these trade names, cited above must have the authorisation of the UTMB®
7. Organisers agree to register no trade mark containing or resembling one of the trade names cited in paragraph (6) above.
8. The organiser agrees that their event will be organised with respect to the values of trail-running, as stated in the ITRA's ethical charter [[http://itra.run/page/258/Charte\\_ethique.html](http://itra.run/page/258/Charte_ethique.html)]

*All public and official communications made must be made with respect to the name of our event and the registered trade-marks. The non-respect of this rule will provoke the removal of the race form the list of the Ultra-Trail du Mont-Blanc® qualifying races.*

*We tolerate the use of the Ultra-Trail® trademark in the name of a race, free of charge, subject to a preliminary request and precise conditions and further to a prior written agreement.*

*1/ Only applications for races of at least 100 km will be considered.*

*2/ No race or event can use the Ultra-Trail® trademark in isolation.*

*3/ If the Ultra-Trail® trademark is used, it must be written with the «U» and the «T» in capital letters, with the dash between Ultra and Trail and with the «®» following Trail.*
